

UPDATED Covid-19 Safety Precautions

Stage Door Dance Academy ~ Reopening Protocols

Entering Dance Studio



- Please arrive no earlier than 5 minutes prior to your scheduled class start time.
- Please park your car and walk your dancer to the designated drop off/ pick up area where a staff member will be waiting to walk your child into the studio.
- **ONLY STUDENTS** may enter the facility with the exception of Wee Dance and Twinkling Stars. One parent or guardian of Wee Dancers and Twinkling Stars is allowed inside with them.
- If your dancer should require you to walk them into the building for personal reasons, please contact us at sddavirtualclasses@gmail.com before class day for approval.
- Students (and adults) are required to wear a mask when entering the building.
- Students will be escorted into their classroom where they will be required to use hand sanitizer prior to class.
- Please exit the parking lot as soon as your dancer is admitted into the studio to allow enough room for the next set of families entering the parking lot.

Class in the Dance Studio

- You may only bring a small bag with your dance shoes and labeled water bottle with you to class.
- Dancers will enter and be directed to "X's" where they may keep their belongings.
- Dancers will then be directed to their 6 foot square on the floors.
- Barres will be marked at 6ft increments, and sanitized after each use.
- All people, including dancers, faculty and staff will be required to wear a face mask at all times, including during class.
 - **A minimum 2-ply/2 layer covering is required.**
 - Gators and bandannas are not 2-ply/2-layer and therefore **DO NOT** qualify as masks.
- Dancers and teachers will not have any contact including holding hands during class or recital dances.
- All dances will be modified to refrain from dancer contact and any hand holding.
- If your dancer has more than one class in a row, they will be instructed how to move between studios in a safe manner.



Exiting the Dance Studio

- All People are required to wear a mask when exiting the building.
- Teachers will walk the class outside and make sure the dancers are released to their families.
- Please park your car and walk to the designated dancer pick-up area.
- **Please have a sign in hand with your dancer's full name in clear view for easy identification.**
- Students **must** be picked up at the class ending time.
- Dancers will not be allowed to stay in the building after their class finishes.
- It is imperative that families are prompt for the safety of your dancer and our facility.





Faculty

- All faculty will wear a mask in the building.
- All faculty will wear a mask while teaching.
- Temperatures will be taken daily.
- All faculty are required to wash hands or use hand sanitizer before entering / re-entering the building and the studios.

Facility

- Hand sanitizer stations are in each studio and at the front desk.
- Our lobby is open for only 1 parent or guardian of dancers in Wee Dance & Twinkling Stars.
 - Any adult that observes classes from the lobby is required to wear a mask while inside the premises and is to maintain social distancing.
- No other family members or friends will be permitted in the lobby to observe classes.
- Dancers must arrive dressed in their dance attire.
- A staff member will be at the front desk during all classes.
- Sanitation will happen frequently.
- The bathroom will be sanitized between each use.
- Please note the additional time between each class for sanitation.



Who Should Not Come to Dance Class

- Anyone uncomfortable with sending their child to the studio for any reason.
- Anyone with a dancer or family member that feels ill or has a fever.
- Anyone living with an immunocompromised family member.
- Anyone living or interacting with elderly people on a regular basis.
- Anyone that has been exposed to someone that has tested positive for COVID-19 in the last 14 days.
- Anyone who has traveled to states experiencing a surge in new COVID-19 cases should quarantine for a 14-day period from the time of last contact within the identified state areas.
